

**La Carrera Pandemica**  
**Virtual Tour 26<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> October 2020**  
**Information**

1. This is the second virtual tour organised by CCHMSC of the 2020 season. We had hoped to be doing real tours by now but unfortunately that has not been possible. The first virtual tour in April has proved very popular so here we are again with our new autumnal offering – “La Carrera Pandemica”
2. **What is it?** - La Carrera Pandemica is a virtual tour taking place starting on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2020 and ending on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> October 2020. The event is open to all comers, having had entries from England, France, Ireland and Italy for the April event.
3. **What do I need?** – You must have an email address and you should be familiar with “Google Maps” and the internet. You may refer to any source of information to complete the event.
4. **How does it work?** – Firstly you will enter the event on the official entry form (just like the real thing) and return it to [mag@kinbrylie.com](mailto:mag@kinbrylie.com) by midnight on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2020. You can enter individually or as a crew. The entry fee is Zero. No entry fee, no accommodation, no fuel – cheapest event you’ll ever do!
5. **Vehicle?** - You will enter in your “ideal virtual car” – i.e. let your imagination run riot – always fancied doing a tour in a Bugatti Veyron? – OK then that’s your virtual car. It has to be something that exists or has existed, though – no Batmobiles and the like please! At the end of the tour entrants will be asked to vote for the “Car of the Event” – a kind of virtual Concour’s d’Elegance.
6. **What happens next?** - After your entry is in you will get an email accepting your entry. A set of Final Instructions will be issued to all entrants on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> October. On Day 1 of the tour, 26<sup>th</sup> October you will get an email with the maps for Day 1, which can be printed off, a set of questions/tasks for Day 1 and an answer sheet for the WHOLE TOUR. Then get scratching your heads and answer the questions for Day 1.
7. **After that?** – Each day you will be sent a new set of maps for the day and a new set of questions – there will be 10 questions for each day until the last day, October 29<sup>th</sup> when the tour ends. You will be given until midnight on 30<sup>th</sup> October to complete the answer sheet, which you will send to [david.spence47@btinternet.com](mailto:david.spence47@btinternet.com) for marking – you must return the sheet by the due time to be classed as a finisher.
8. **Awards?** – One point will be awarded for each correct answer. All finishers will be awarded an individual finishers’ certificate, gold, silver or bronze according to the number of points scored and the “winner” with the most points will be given a special award. Results will be announced on 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> November. The winners of the Concours will be announced at the same time.
