

TRIESTE OPICINA HISTORIC 2016 – General description and Program

a) Regularity Run for Vintage and Classic Cars, free instrumentation according to ASI rules. (please see ASI General Regulations).

b) Non – competitive Tour of Trieste and its Territory.

The Regularity is also valid for AACC, Alpe Adria Classic Challenge (www.aa-cc.eu).

As an additional source of interest and entertainment for participants, this year a special classification for Marque-teams is introduced: every competitor will be included in Marque –teams (Abarth, Autobianchi, Lancia, Alfa Romeo, Porsche, FIAT, Mercedes, Mini, MG, Austin Healey, Triumph, Jaguar, Volvo, Saab, Puch, Ferrari, Maserati, Etceterini). The Team Trophy will be awarded to the team with the best sum of the scores of its top five crews (Detailed Rules to be published shortly)..

Friday, April 1st, 2016

For club-members and their guests only: 55th Anniversary of Club dei Venti all’Ora (march 1961)

09.30: gathering at the Rivolto Air Base, home of the PAN national acrobatic jet-aircraft team “Frecce Tricolori” for official visit and exchange of pennants (PAN also was established in 1961)

13.00 : lunch in nearby restaurant or pub

14.30: departure for Trieste – Porto Vecchio (Old Harbour)

14.30: departure to Trieste of other historic car groups from Cividale del Friuli (UNESCO), San Daniele (Strada dei Castelli e dei Saponi) , Palmanova and Gorizia.

17.00: Concentration Run and gathering of all other historic car clubs: pre-war cars, historical buses and all the crews registered for the Race.

17.30: Official Opening of Trieste Opicina Historic 2016, special edition 55/105 (55 years of the club, 105 years from the first race in 1911) and inaugural toast with snacks.

Saturday, April 2nd, 2016

Non – competitive Run.

9.30: at Museo Ferroviario di Trieste Campo Marzio (Trieste Campo Marzio railway station museum), registration of participants to the touristic kermesse (Touring Class) and material distribution. Chance to visit the Museum from 9:30 to 10:00

10.00: from Museo Ferroviario, departure of Touring Class to Castello di Duino (Duino Castle) belonging to Thurn und Taxis noble family. Subsequently Aquileia (UNESCO) with a quick visit of the area

13.00: lunch at Castello di Spessa (Spessa Castle) including a visit to their magnificent wine cellar.

14.30: return through a touristic route with a visit to another wine cellar or similar.

17.30: gathering in Villa Opicina (Opicina Village), joining with Sport Class en-route from the railway station museum.

18.00: welcome in Villa Opicina by the local community and the Consortium “Insieme ad Opicina”. Presence of historical Opicina Tramway- carriages and short show/concert/entertainment.

14.00: registration and administrative checks in Museo Ferroviario di Trieste Campo Marzio, with time for visits.

16.31: first sport car starts in the Regularity Run
17.30: gathering in Villa Opicina, also with prewar cars and touring participants
18.00: welcome in Villa Opicina by the local community and the Consortium “Insieme ad Opicina”. Presence of historical Opicina Tramway carriages cars and a short show/concert/entertainment.

9.30: departure of the second leg from Villa Opicina – touristic route around Krast-Plateau and its villages.

10.30: guided tour of Sincrotrone (particle accelerator), near Science Park in Basovizza – our scientific context of excellence opens to Trieste Opicina

12.30: gathering in Piazza Verdi (Verdi Square) in Trieste, between Piazza dell’Unità d’Italia (Italy Union Square), Galleria al Tergesteo (Tergesteo Arcade) and Teatro Verdi (Verdi Opera House), also with prewar cars and Sport Class. Toast and snacks in the most elegant part of Trieste.

13.15: Departure from Piazza Verdi to Porto Vecchio (Old Harbour)

14.30: Final lunch and prize-giving ceremony
